## Updates

- **FRAC:** Reconvening of committees is on the horizon- be on the lookout for Chair communications. An evaluation committee will be initiated as well.

- **Legislative:** Children's Action Alliance CEO Dana Naimark presented in lieu of Kelley Murphy. They have created a 2018 voters' guide. CAA recommends a NO vote on Prop 126 (preemptive prohibition of any state tax on services) and a NO vote on Prop 305 (expansion of state voucher system allowing for diversion of public education funds to private institutions). Dana recommended the AzPHA website for reviews of other propositions.
