## **Take action immediately when you get a notice from the Department of Economic Security, AHCCCS, or your health care plan.**

Check your mailbox and respond with the requested information to confirm you are eligible.

If you need help, or become ineligible for AHCCCS or KidsCare, **Cover Arizona** has an online appointment system that connects Arizonans to no-cost, bilingual, certified application assistance: virtual or in-person appointments are available for AHCCCS, KidsCare, SNAP, and the Health Insurance Marketplace (Obamacare).

When someone loses AHCCCS or KidsCare they are most likely eligible for the Health Insurance Marketplace (Obamacare). Some people will qualify for a no-cost health plan while others will find low monthly premiums, often less than \$10 a month.

Help us spread the word to family, friends, neighbors, and anyone else who might be enrolled in AHCCCS (Medicaid) or KidsCare (CHIP) to keep everyone who is eligible covered!
